Background:

Buffalo Urban Teaching Fellows (BUTF) launched in 2023 in partnership with TNTP, a national leader in teacher recruitment and development. The Cullen Foundation of Western New York, Inc. is a proud sponsor of the BUTF program, which is a cornerstone of Cullen's human capital strategy.

Since 2020, Cullen's grant commitment to the BUTF initiative totals nearly \$3.4 million:

- Seed funding for research, analysis and partnership outreach, leading to BUTF's formation: \$459,690
- Multi-year funding for BUTF's staffing and operations through 2027: \$2,095,207
- Direct tuition & stipend support committed to Cohort One and Cohort Two Fellows: \$810,827

Mission:

Buffalo Urban Teaching Fellows (BUTF) is an "earn and learn" teacher training program. It provides aspiring teachers ("Fellows") with a paid role in a school and significant tuition assistance while they pursue certification and transition to a teaching career. With embedded development opportunities and a cohort experience, this program helps Fellows make a meaningful difference in the lives of local students.



Partnership - Who Does What:

Through TNTP, BUTF provides outreach, recruitment, mentoring, wraparound services, and other supports to Fellows.

BUTF is led by Director Melissa A. Lopez, an award-winning educator with deep expertise in teacher development, experience as a teacher leader, and more than a decade of classroom teaching experience. Melissa and TNTP are leading the work of BUTF and are in the early phases of working with a local organization to support the future work of BUTF.
